

# Adder <sup>F1</sup>



Formally BRC 7681

**Maturity:**

Versatile maturity, approximately 75 -80 days from transplant during Summer and slightly longer going into Autumn.

**Plant:**

Strong, very upright plant style. The head is set medium to deep within the plant. Good heat tolerance.

**Head Quality:**

Very uniform high domed heads, dark green in colour with medium sized bead. Adder produces quality heads up to 120mm in diameter, requiring minimal trimming.

**Harvest Season:**

Generally early Summer through to Autumn. In the upper North we have had promising results into winter.
